5.3.1.3 Trails

All of the HCLE alternatives intersect and coincide with planned trails. The Alternative 1a bandwidth includes the greatest length of trails, at 41,978 m (137,724 ft). Alternative 1b also intersects over 40,000 m (approximately 133,000 ft) of trails. The planned trails are not Section 4(f) resources, however, because they are not currently publicly owned or subject to public easements. There are opportunities for joint planning of the CETAP improvements and the planned trails to include appropriate road crossing designs and other measures to protect the recreation value of the planned trails. Joint planning, incorporation of design features, and development of mitigation measures will occur at the Tier 2 level for the selected alternative.

5.3.2 Archaeological and Historic Resources

All identified cultural resources have the potential to be significant and National Register eligible, until such time as testing is conducted to ascertain the value of the site. In order to identify resources of special concern at the Tier 1 level (i.e., those resources with a higher likelihood of qualifying for National Register listing) each alternative was evaluated with regard to any proportionately higher occurrence of one type of site. A preponderance of a single type of site was an indicator of possible resource clusters. The records for these resources were re-examined, and a determination made as to the potential significance of the resource. If the site or site clusters were determined to be resources of special concern, an analysis of topography and other site constraints was conducted to determine the likelihood of avoiding the resource when siting the ultimate right-of-way for the alternative.
