



## **Reche Canyon**

Reche Canyon is a small rural enclave located in the northwest portion of the Reche Canyon/Badlands area, in the hills east of the Box Springs Mountains. Uses are primarily large-lot, equestrian-oriented and rural residential uses.

## **INCORPORATED CITIES**

The boundaries of the Reche Canyon/Badlands area encompass the City of Moreno Valley. Incorporated in 1984, Moreno Valley contains approximately 32,700 acres, with a population of over 141,000. A portion of the City's Sphere of Influence extends within the southern portion of the planning area. Land use and development within Moreno Valley is governed by the City's general plan and zoning code.



*A "sphere of influence" is the area outside of and adjacent to a city's border that the city has identified as a future logical extension of its jurisdiction. While the County of Riverside has land use authority over city sphere areas, development in these areas directly affects circulation, service provision, and community character within the cities.*
