Western yellow-billed cuckoo	California: Threatened	Riparian forest
Southwestern willow flycatcher	California: Endangered Federal: Endangered	Riparian scrub, woodland and forest
Peregrine falcon	California: Endangered Federal: Endangered	Agriculture, meadows and marshes, coniferous forest, riparian scrub, woodlands
Bald eagle	California: Endangered Federal: Threatened	Meadows and marshes, coniferous forest, riparian scrub, water, woodland
California gnatcatcher	Federal: Threatened	Coastal sage scrub, alluvial fan scrub
Least Bell's vireo	California: Endangered Federal: Endangered	Riparian scrub and woodland
San Bernardino kangaroo rat	Federal: Endangered	Coastal sage scrub, alluvial fan scrub
Stephen's kangaroo rat	California: Threatened Federal: Endangered	Coastal sage scrub (sparse), grassland, alluvial fan scrub (sparse)
Southwestern arroyo toad	Federal: Endangered	Riparian scrub (breeding), chaparral, coastal sage scrub, grassland, alluvial fan scrub, woodlands (estivation)
California red-legged frog	Federal: Threatened	Riparian scrub (breeding), meadows and marshes (livestock ponds)
Mountain yellow-legged frog	Federal: Proposed Endangered	Montane forest and woodlands near water, lake borders
Quino checkerspot butterfly	Federal: Endangered	Chaparral (openings), coastal sage scrub, grassland, playas and vernal pools, woodlands (open canopies)

San Jacinto Valley crownscale	Federal: Endangered	Grassland (alkaline), playas and vernal pools
Nevin's barberry	California: Endangered Federal: Endangered	Chaparral, alluvial fan scrub
Thread-leaved brodiaea	California: Endangered Federal: Threatened	Grassland and vernal pools (clay, loamy-sand, alkaline silty clay)
Vail Lake ceanothus	California: Threatened Federal: Threatened	Chamise (on ultra-basic parent rock) and gabbro (weathered)
Slender-horned spineflower	California: Endangered Federal: Endangered	Chaparral (gravels in open chamise), woodlands (open canopies)
Santa Ana River woolly-star	California: Endangered Federal: Endangered	Washes and early succession alluvial fan scrub
San Diego button celery	California: Endangered Federal: Endangered	Playas and vernal pools
Spreading navarretia	Federal: Threatened	Playas and vernal pools
California Orcutt grass	California: Endangered Federal: Endangered	Playas and vernal pools
